The “Advances in Finance and Accounting” (AFA) Professional + Research Master’s degree prepares you for careers in insurance, banking, corporate market finance, financial markets, accounting, financial institutions, consulting and auditing firms.

Entry requirements

Eligibility

University degree of 240 ECTS; for non-Europeans, a 4-year university degree minimum (approved by a university committee). Application form.

Advanced level in English (TOEIC, TOEFL, etc.)

Target audience


Students possessing M1 or M2 degree in management, economics, mathematics, science, or engineering, and second or third year students from management or engineering schools are invited to apply.

Depending on the number of available places, access to the “Advances in Finance and Accounting” Master’s program is automatically conferred to students having obtained the necessary ECTS credits in the Master 1 program of Finance at Grenoble IAE.

Course curriculum

The "Advanced in finance and accounting" degree is obtained in 1 year, requiring the validation of 120 credits over 2 semesters.
